What Is the House System?

How It Works

- You'll be sorted into your House at our very first Big House Meeting!
- **Big House Meetings** (every 4-6 weeks): Full-school celebrations, competitions, and leadership showcases.
- **Small House Meetings**: Led by House staff and student leaders in between with activities, check-ins, and bonding.

House Council

Houses will hold elections for student leaders to serve on a House Council where they will build their leadership skills and help plan for the fun, solve problems, and be a voice for the student body.

Community Connection

Each house will develop a partnership with a local organization to build community connection. This will create opportunities for speakers to come in, students to serve and connect to those organizations, and build an understanding that they are part of a larger world.

Parent Involvement

Once the students are sorted, parents will know which house to support. We welcome parent involvement in house activities whether that's helping organize events and activities or just attending a house meeting to feel the spirit. Parents will also get notified when their child earns points so they can reinforce the positive behavior at home.
